**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DETERMINE
CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS PURSUANT TO FLORIDA RULE OF
JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION 2.420 (c) (9) AND (d) (1)**

THIS CAUSE, having come before this Court on respondent's *Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records Pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420 (c) (9) and (d) (1)* filed on August 11, 2025, and the Court having reviewed the pleadings of record, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is thereupon:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Respondent's Motion is hereby GRANTED.
2. The Clerk of Court is directed to immediately seal and maintain as confidential the following portions of the record, removing them from public view, as they contain sensitive information regarding the minor child and a third party:
 - a) Page 2, Sections 4 and 5, of the Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage, filed August 6, 2025; and
 - b) Page 1 of the Marital Settlement Agreement filed July 12, 2025.

These sections disclose the minor child's full name and the biological father's full name.


