ORDER TO SEAL

THIS ACTION having come before the Court at a hearing on June 22, 2026 on Defendant's request to seal this case; the Plaintiff having failed to appear and the Defendants having appeared, *pro se*; and the Court having considered the factors set forth in Rule 2.420(e)(3), Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin., finds as follows:

- A. This is an eviction case.
- B. The documents filed herein could be detrimental to the Defendant's ability to secure safe housing in the future.
- C. The parties' names are not determined to be confidential.
- D. The progress dockets or similar records generated to document activity in the case are not confidential.
- E. The contents of all documents filed in the case are determined to be confidential.
- F. No persons are permitted to view the confidential information, except Clerk of Court employees, the Court, and the parties.
- G. That the Court finds that: (i) the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set

forth in subdivision (c); and (ii) no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c).

It is, therefore, ORDERED that the documents in this case are SEALED, and the Clerk of the Court is directed to publish the Order in accordance with subdivision (e)(4).


