

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OVERVIEW

As requested by the Clerk of Circuit and County Court, Lake County, Florida and scheduled as part of the Annual Audit Plan for FY 2010-2011, the Internal Audit department has conducted a verification of the fixed asset records of Lake County. The purpose of the fixed asset verification was to provide assurance to management that the assets recorded in the fixed asset system (FASGOV) exist and are accurately accounted for. This audit verification was conducted between 5/1/2011 and 10/15/2011.

The Fixed Asset section of the Procurement Services division serves the county by ensuring that all county fixed assets are properly accounted for and disposed of in the most cost-effective and regulatory-compliant manner. Fixed assets recorded in FASGOV include all assets with a value of \$1,000 or more and a useful life of more than one year. In May of each year, the Fixed Asset/Surplus Manager sends each asset custodian a detailed listing of all assets under their area of responsibility. Custodians are required to physically verify the existence of each asset on their listing or provide appropriate documentation to support why the item was not verified. Once all items are verified, the listings are signed by the custodian and returned to the Fixed Asset/Surplus Manager so they can be reviewed and updated in FASGOV.

In order to achieve reasonable assurance that all fixed assets were physically verified by asset custodians, we randomly selected a sample of fixed assets assigned to each department and physically verified their existence using the county asset tag number and/or serial number. The total number of items available for verification was 9,848. The number of items randomly selected to be verified by Internal Audit was 1,058 or 10.7 percent. Of the number of items included in the random sample, 100% of the items were verified as present and accounted for.

The courtesies and cooperation extended by employees of departments during the audit were sincerely appreciated.

OPINION

Based on the documented results of the completed inventory, observations made during the audit verification process, the data collected and analyzed, and the information provided herein, the fixed asset records of Lake County are sufficiently accurate and acceptable for inclusion in the official accounting records.
