Have your jury summons available, because both the website and the message will refer to your group number listed below the PIN located at the top of this summons. If neither the website nor the telephone line is in operation, please report for jury duty as indicated on this summons. **If you need additional information, please call the Jury Division at (352) 742-4160 between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.**

If you are a person with a disability who needs any accommodation in order to participate in this proceeding, you are entitled, at no cost to you, to the provision of certain assistance. Please contact the ADA Coordinator at the Office of the Trial Court Administrator, Lake County Courthouse, P.O. Box 7800, 550 W. 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****PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING JUROR INFORMATION CAREFULLY****

ELECTRONIC DEVICES will be removed from all members of the jury panel before jury deliberations begin and, as directed by the presiding judge, may be removed at other stages of a trial. At the beginning of the trial, the presiding judge will advise the jury panel about the removal of electronic devices.

WHAT MAY I BRING? Because delays often occur between processing jurors and assigning them to trials, you may want to bring reading or writing materials to fill this time. Newspapers are NOT allowed. Our security staff prohibits bringing pocket knives, chemical sprays, or any other weapons into the Courthouse. **You may bring snacks. Beverages and snacks are also available for purchase.**

HOW LONG MUST I PLAN TO SERVE? Jury duty will normally last for one day or until the trial on which you are serving as a juror is completed, which may include several days. Usually, if you are not selected to serve by the end of the first day, you will have completed your jury obligation and you will be released. However, jury duty may be extended beyond these limits to meet the needs of the court. Please be prepared and make arrangements to remain for the entire day, which could be after 5 p.m.

WHAT MAY I WEAR? Please dress appropriately. Do not wear beach attire or shorts. You may wish to bring a jacket or sweater because courtrooms are kept at a very cool temperature.

WHERE MUST I PARK? Please use the free parking garage located at 200 N. Sinclair Ave., Tavares.

WHAT IS MY PAY? If you work for pay, ask your employer if he or she will pay your regular wages while you serve on jury duty. If your employer does not continue to pay your usual wages while you serve on jury duty, or if you do not work for pay, Florida Statutes state that you will receive \$15 per day. If your employer continues to pay your usual wages, you will receive no pay for the first three days of jury duty. After serving three days, all jurors will receive \$30 per day. There is no added pay for mileage.
